## LEARNING GRAMMAR IN A FUN AND INTERACTIVE WAY

It's no secret that German grammar can be a bit challenging. To make it easier for children to understand, learn, and practise, there are creative approaches - one of which is the Montessori method. Using this method, children can learn the parts of speech in German in a fun, imaginative, and interactive way, which also makes their learning and thinking visible!

In the Year 2 German programme, children were first introduced to the story "The Land of Speech Parts." In this story, each part of speech has its own symbol - for example, the noun is represented by a black triangle. Each part of speech is presented through an interactive story or game, leaving a lasting impression on the children.





At the beginning, the children meet **Prince and Princess Noun**, who rule the Land of the Parts of Speech. They give names to all objects, people, feelings, animals, and plants. All nouns are divided into different categories, and each category has its own castle. This imaginative setting helps children understand that all people, animals, things, plants, and feelings have names, live in a castle in this story, and must be written with a capital letter because they are names.







But Prince and Princess Noun don't like to be alone that's why they always have a little guard with them: the definite or indefinite article.

So far in Year 2, the children have learned only nouns and articles. There are many more parts of speech to discover, and I can't wait to continue the story and show the children the rest of the exciting adventures in the Land of Speech Parts!

A set of exercises complements the story, helping children practise their knowledge of the parts of speech. These exercises follow the same symbols and story, reinforcing grammar and sentence structure in a fun and memorable way.

### Exploring stories, feelings, and the wider world through drama and writing

In Year 1, the children have been exploring the story *Beegu* by Alexis Deacon through our IPC and English work. They stepped into Beegu's shoes, using drama to imagine what it might be like to land on Earth and not be understood. Through activities such as "alien talk" games and hot-seating, the children developed empathy and confidence in speaking and listening, while meeting key expectations from the Year 1 National Curriculum.



Building on this, the children planned brand-new adventures for Beegu, imagining her visiting famous landmarks around the world such as the Eiffel Tower and the Great Wall of China. They enjoyed sequencing events, drawing pictures, and writing diary entries from Beegu's point of view. The work was fun and engaging, but it also supported important skills in literacy and geography - helping children practise writing sentences, using time words, and describing feelings, while developing a sense of global awareness.







# INTRODUCING OUR NEW SENSORY SPACES: THE DEN AND THE CALM COVE

This year, our Inclusion and Early Years teams are delighted to share the development of two dedicated Sensory Spaces in school - The Den in Primary and The Calm Cove in Early Years. These calm, supportive environments provide children with safe places to regulate their emotions, build confidence, and prepare themselves for successful learning.

## Why Sensory Spaces Matter

Research shows that sensory-friendly environments have a profound impact on children's development. When children are provided with calm, structured opportunities to regulate their nervous systems, they are better able to:

Manage emotions - lowering stress and anxiety and reducing the likelihood of emotional overwhelm.

*Improve cognitive function* - regulation activates the "thinking brain," making it easier to concentrate, solve problems, and retain information.

Build self-esteem - being given a safe, welcoming space communicates that children's feelings are valid and manageable, which boosts confidence and resilience.

Develop social skills - calm spaces provide the foundation for positive interactions with peers, as children are more able to listen, share, and communicate when regulated. Neuroscience research (Center on the Developing Child, Harvard University) shows that children learn best when their brains are calm and organised. A regulated child can engage their prefrontal cortex (responsible for reasoning, memory, and focus) rather than being stuck in a stress-response state. This means that the benefits of sensory spaces extend far beyond wellbeing - they directly support academic learning and long-term development.







#### **How We Use These Spaces**

The Den and The Calm Cove are already being used as hubs for learning and support, used in many different ways:

Academic Support Groups - small group interventions, memory and recall practice, and targeted learning.

Motor Skills Development - activities to strengthen both gross and fine motor skills, supporting handwriting, coordination, and independence.

Social Groups - guided opportunities for children to practise turn-taking, teamwork, and building friendships through Lego and other activities.

Reflection and Emotional Regulation - a safe, welcoming place for children to take time out, manage big feelings, and return to class ready to learn.











### **Supporting the Whole Child**

Our goal as the Inclusion team, and indeed as a whole school, is to nurture every child emotionally, socially, and academically. The sensory spaces allow us to meet children where they are, offering both proactive support (through groups and targeted teaching) and responsive support (through safe reflection time when emotions run high).

Our hope is that these spaces give children the message that they are valued, capable, and supported - an ethos that is one of the foundations our school community is built on. By helping them feel calm, confident, and connected, we are unlocking their ability to succeed - not only in their learning today, but in building the self-esteem and resilience they will carry into the future.
